

How to get to Queen Square

Arriving by national rail:

Buses leave from the following mainline train stations to Russell Square:

Euston – 68,168, 59, 91

King's Cross – 59, 91

Waterloo – 59, 168, 188

Charing Cross – 91

Paddington - 7

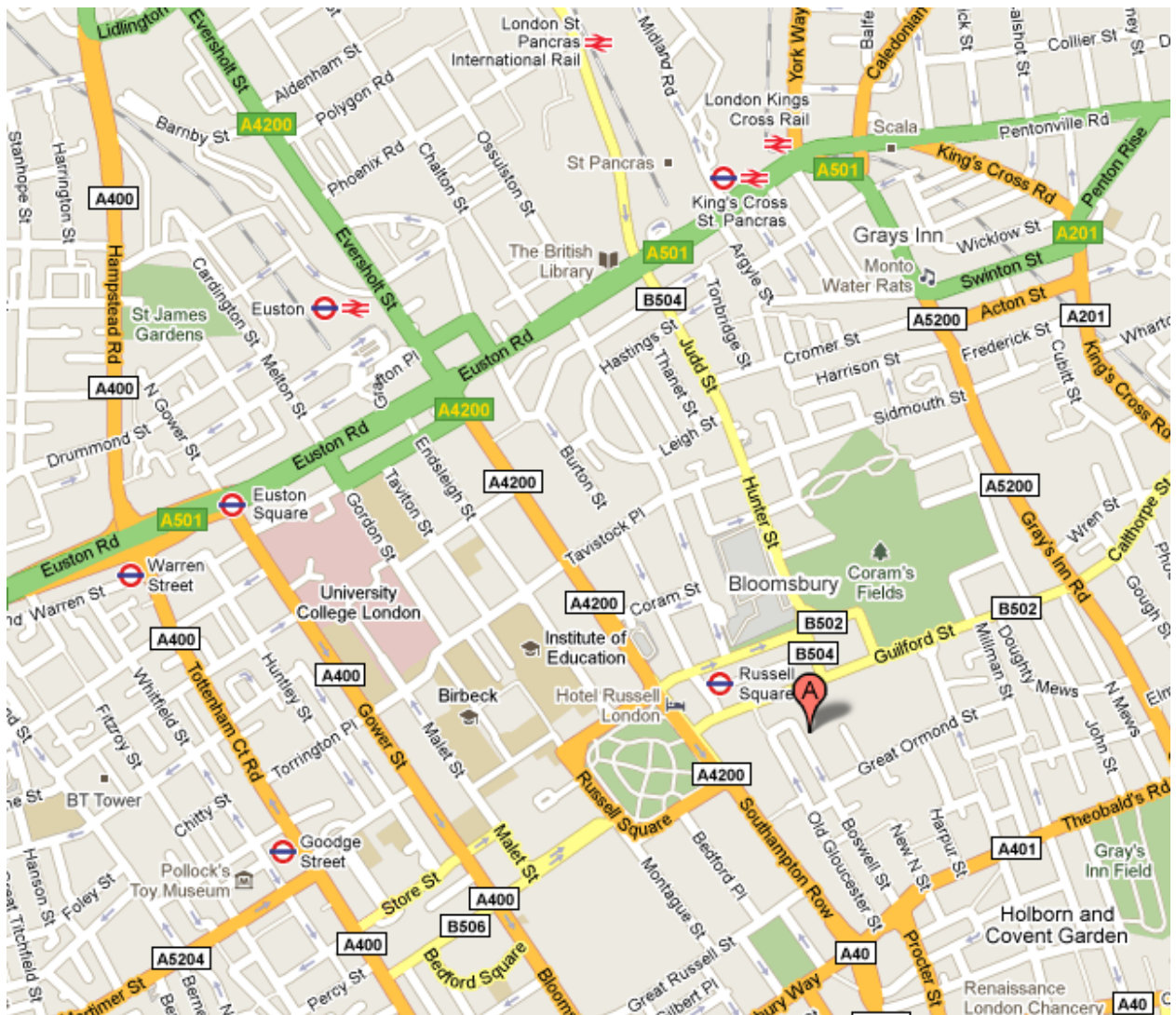
Arriving by car:

Parking is available at the NCP Brunswick Square car park on Marchmont Street, London WC1N 1AF, which is a five minute walk to Guildford Street. The cost is £15.50 for 24 hours.

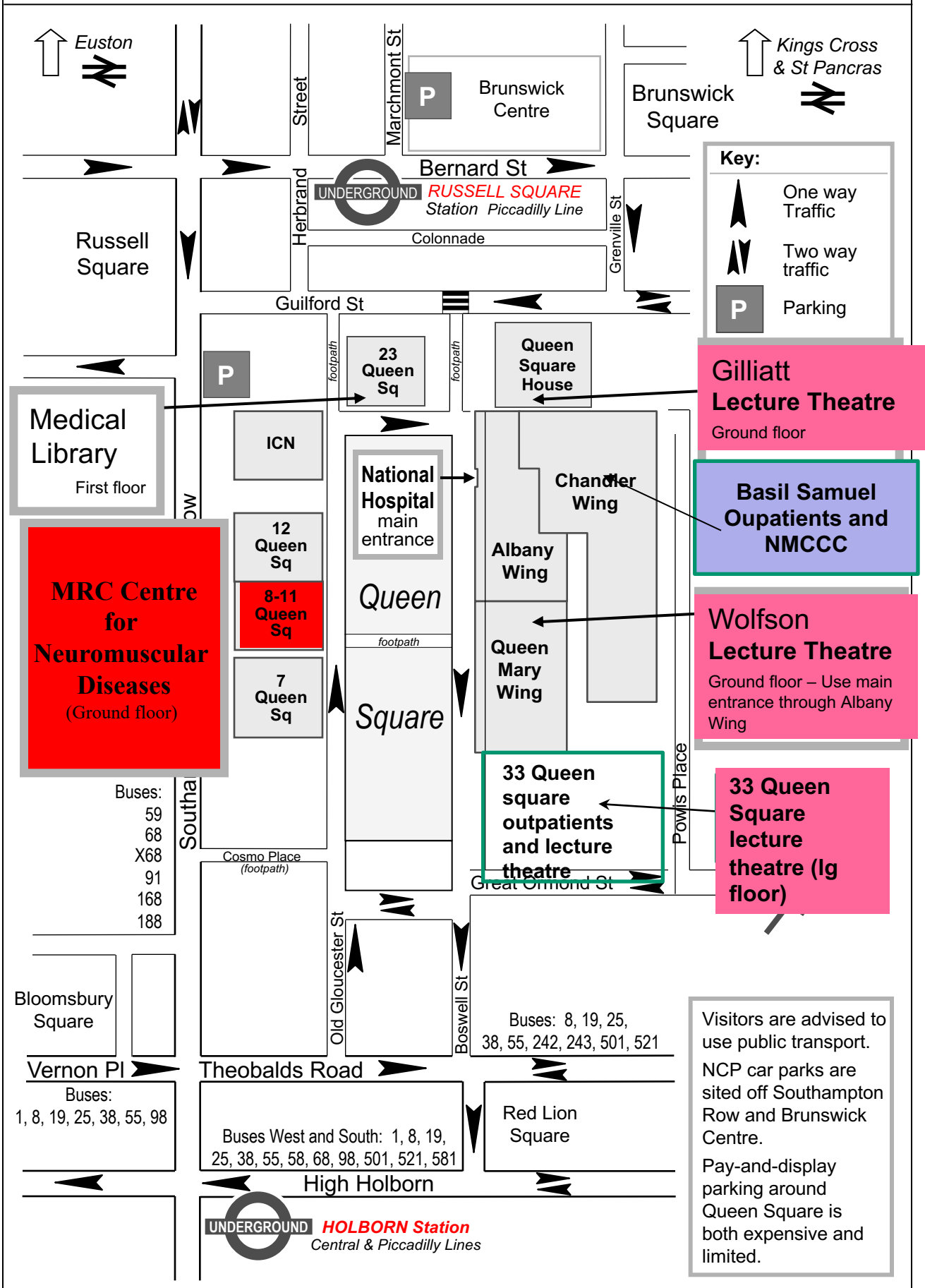
