

Mentorship Programme for those interested in Clinical Neurophysiology

Clinical Neurophysiology is a medical specialty dedicated to the study of the central and peripheral nervous systems. It comprises around 150 consultants and 30 specialist registrars across the United Kingdom. In 2023, as part of providing junior doctors with better access into the specialty and its opportunities, the Association of Trainees in Clinical Neurophysiology joined forces with trainees nationwide to provide a mentorship programme for junior doctors.

Aims

The Mentorship Programme for those interested in Clinical Neurophysiology aims to provide a better exposure to the specialty and provide career development opportunities through one-to-one pairing with a specialist registrar in the field. Mentors can offer advice about career progression, life as a clinical neurophysiology registrar as well as general support and guidance for developing a career in clinical neurophysiology, including exploring relevant clinical experience opportunities wherever possible.

Eligibility

- Mentees must have completed their medical training
- Priority will be given to those in one of the following four core training programmes or equivalent stages of medical career who are interested in Clinical Neurophysiology:
 - Internal Medicine (IM) Stage 1
 - Acute Care Common Stem - Internal Medicine (ACCS-IM)
 - Level 1 Paediatric training - visit the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health website for further details
 - Core Surgical Training
