#### **Content updates**

Over the last two years we have been reviewing and updating our elearning sessions (over 500 done, 25 to go!)

#### **Activity**

There are 9685 registered users, between 20 and 40 log in every day, 70.3% are returning visitors 16,719 sessions and 258,998 pages were accessed in 2018



79% of learners are from Europe but learners from 126 countries have accessed ebrain at least once in 2018

The formative question exercises in Neurology and Neurosurgery are the most popular content
